Dyslexia Awareness Week 2017 takes place from **2nd October** in England, Ireland and Wales, this years theme is the 'Positive about Dyslexia'.



These awards will be given to individuals who have been successful in spite of the challenges they have faced with their dyslexia in the following categories.;


- Child (age 12 and under)

Dyslexia – Some facts



Dyslexia: the Facts

- On average three children in every classroom are dyslexic and struggle with literacy (around 1.2 million children).
- One in five 11 year olds currently move from primary to secondary education with below expected levels of literacy.
- At secondary level, over a third of young people failed to achieve the expected level of an A+ to C in English in 2011.






About Us
